Dear Wesley Preschool and Play Care Family,

This letter will serve as an update on the status of Wesley Preschool and Play Care, specifically through summer camp and play care. At the last update, the Board voted to remain closed through June 15 following recommendations outlined by the Governor.

While Phase 2 of the states reopening allows WPS to open June 15, the Board has voted to remain closed for an additional two weeks to better prepare for a reopening on Monday, June 29. Staff has been planning, cleaning, and preparing for a hopeful cautious reopening in the past weeks. We feel it is our responsibility to provide families and staff with a detailed plan of procedures.


You will receive an updated packet related to Wesley's COVID-19 Child Care Plan. This plan will align with the states guidelines as well as CDC recommendations. Over the next week, staff and Director will develop a written plan that addresses our preschool's prevention and response to COVID-19. We encourage you to review the above template and direct any questions and comments to the Director to aid in the best plan for Wesley Preschool, staff, and families. Wesley's plan will be released to you Monday, June 15 with reopening Monday, June 29.
