Sermon Topic: Parade of Folly

Adam and Eve (the fruit) Genesis 3

Noah (drunk on new wine) (*Genesis 6:9* – Noah is righteous, and then *9:18-27* – drunk and angry)

Jacob – the trickster, later named Israel (*Genesis* 25:29-34 – taking advantage and *Genesis* 27:18-29, - lying to his father)

Moses and Aaron – disobedience and pride (*Numbers 20:1-13* – the waters of Meribah)

Saul – Impatience, unlawful sacrifice 1 Samuel 13:8-14 - ("You have done foolishly")

Naaman anger and pride (2 Kings 5:1-14)

David – breaks 4 commandments (1 - self-centered pride, 6 - murder, 7 - adultery, and 10 - covetousness) (2 Samuel 11:1-12:23) followed by confrontation and acknowledgement of sin, (*Psalm 51* abject humility, acknowledgement of helplessness, and begging not to be cast out)

Solomon – wisdom into folly (1 Kings 11:1-13 straying from God)

Disciples and the Sons of Zebedee (right and left hand of Jesus) *Matthew 20:20-28* – pride and anger

Martha when Jesus visits Martha and Mary (Luke 10:38-42) distraction

Peter's denial (Matthew 26:69-75)

Paul (Saul) *Acts* 7:54 – 8:4 (unthinking persecution) and the road to Damascus *Acts* 9:1-19)
